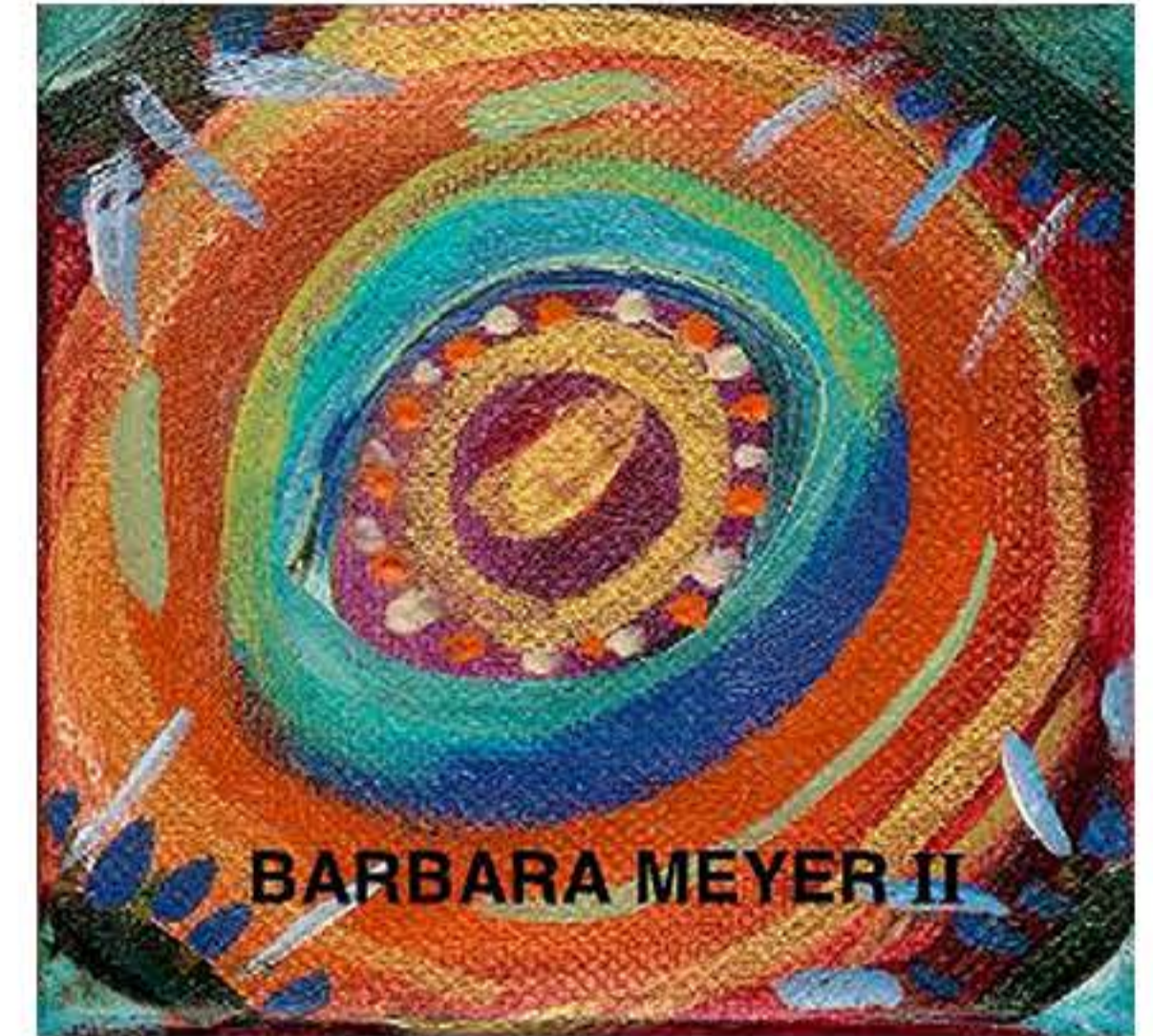

B: GENRE-BENDING. Transformative Artist Barbara Meyer is a singer-songwriter with a background in musical theatre & opera, feet firmly dancing in the jazz realm, and a sonic sensibility that will knock you out.
